I spent my early years watching my grandfather, Walter Charles Tait, at ERPM Bowling greens, till age 10.

He brought me up as a child and thankfully made bowling part of my life.

My mother remarried when I was 10 and we went to live at City Deep Mine JHB. I went to school in Johannesburg at Twist street Primary School, Hillbrow and then Banato Park Girls high.

After leaving school I qualified as a hairdresser at Maison Champagne.

I worked for my mother in law, Mrs Bodil Anderson, and married her son, John Anderson. We lived in Boksburg for 7 Yrs.

This did not work out so we got Divorced. I decided to go to London, to start a new life.

I sailed to London on the Edinburgh Castle. This was good for me as I made firm friends for my UK stay. For the next 3 years I lived in Muswell Hill at Alexander Palace. This gave me the opportunity to travel the UK by car, a group tour through Europe and a Mediterranean cruise.

Back in Johannesburg I worked for a Travel Agent, AATB at Jan Smuts Airport. For the next 7 years, as a guide and agent to businessmen and travelling VIP's.

African countries, Mauritius, Madagascar and Australia . For a number of years for Avex air, Rennies Air. Grand Central Charter. National Airways and Heliquip Aviation.

I then Managed a small Airline with regular flights from Grand Central to Sun City. The down turn in aviation business resulted in aircraft being sold - mostly to Australia .

I was Transferred to an International Company. ISOS International SOS to do medical rescue at Grand Central Airport, for the remaining years till I retired in 2005.

In 2006. I worked part time for Heliquip at Grand Central and then in 2007, did the best thing ever.

I Moved to Centurion and was introduced to the Centurion Bowling Club. Great for me as it has kept me healthy and alive. [Bowls saved my life - this is another story]. Have enjoyed the competitive side of the game and very much the Social and Fitness.
